## Inspire

We have had three Inspire workshops linked to reading for Reception, Year 1 and Year 5. All have been well attended.

## Greening Wingrove and Arthur'S Hill CIC: Wild West End Project

We are working with the Wild West End Project to focus on identifying and monitoring species for which there was little local data, especially swifts, house martins, bats and hedgehogs, and then strengthening habitats in order to sustain or increase numbers. The project would encourage and support residents to report sightings and this data would be logged with appropriate databases.

"In Year Six, we have been looking at hedgehogs. We have been trying to find out if there are any hedgehogs on our field. Using charcoal, oil and food, we have found some footprints. Some of the footprints look like different animals, like cats because we found hair on the paper. The food has hardly been touched so I don't think they like the food. We had fun looking for hedgehogs but sometimes there wasn't any footprints."
